OM Walton presented the bid for the light plant. The bid was provided by William P. Henschel Jr. Material sourcing was discussed and local sources were utilized for this bid. OM Walton mentioned potential savings by switching boilers. Auditor Truver noted that there should not be sales tax on the materials. Per David, if the materials are purchased at Do It Best, there would not be a fee for the plans. Discussion on rafters every two feet versus four feet. Auditor Truver presented options for payment. Auditor Truver discussed fencing for the baseball fields. Rec Director Krieg would like to have volunteers install the fence. Motion to approve baseball fence expenses up to \$3,000 with funds coming from a donation Cavalier Fire Department gaming. M/S/P – Vaughn, Cluchie; 5:0, mc.
